Welcome to Northumberland Wildlife Trust

Dear member,

Thank you for joining Northumberland Wildlife Trust today. As a committed supporter, you are helping to protect local wildlife and to educate and inspire people about nature.

NWT relies on three methods to recruit regular supporters (please tick):

NWT staff employed as recruiters, usually at NWT visitor centres, nature reserves or at fairs/shows;

I am seeking donations on behalf of Northumberland Wildlife Trust. I am being paid an hourly rate of £7.83 (minimum). In all, I expect to be paid approximately £5,500 for carrying out this programme of conversations with supporters like yourself this year.

I work for NWT as a membership recruiter.

An employee from professional fundraising agency FMR Solutions, whose representatives visit your home;

I work for FMR Solutions and we are working for the benefit of Northumberland Wildlife Trust. My organisation is being paid 100% of the first year's annualised membership subscription to recruit supporters like yourself to make regular donations to NWT. Most members stay with NWT an average of 10 years, and we therefore calculate a minimum return of £7 for every £1 spent.

NWT staff (non-fundraising), volunteers or trustees, who are not paid, usually at NWT visitor centres or nature reserves.

The Direct Debit Guarantee

This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.

If there are any changes to the amount, date, or frequency of your Direct Debit, Northumberland Wildlife Trust Ltd will only notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited, or as otherwise agreed. If you request Northumberland Wildlife Trust Ltd to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of request.

If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by Northumberland Wildlife Trust Ltd or your Bank or Building Society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund from your Bank or Building Society. If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Northumberland Wildlife Trust Ltd asks you to.

You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your Bank or Building Society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
